- 1. Review minutes of 8/8/18
 - Approved, all in favor

2. 2018 CLDA/CBA Expenditure Plan

Updated plan sent by Tom Lawrence.

- Reluctant to say there is the full ~ \$68,000 to spend, as much will be tied up in nonfiction purchases
- This would need to be spent 12/31/2018, most logical is to prepay to develop OverDrive content.

3. Catalog Enhancement Information

- Recommend DA to change catalog enhancement to Syndetics Unbound.
- As per Laurie Shedrick some positives include good coverage, similar features including series covers, you may also like feature, easier for the user – do not have to scroll so far down for information. Will be pro-rated based on having some Syndetics content currently.
- Possible Go Live Date in January or February 2019.

4. <u>Review of Database Statistics</u>

A. Chiltons Review

- Recommendation to DA to not resubscribe to Chiltons.
- Discussion: Data driven decision, statically usage is down, people are viewing YouTube and other sources for info.

B. Consumer Reports Review

- Recommendation to DA to not resubscribe to ConsumerReports.
- Discussion: Data driven decision, statically usage is down

C. Exploring a group-buy language learning alternative to Mango?

Discussion:

- Trend is up for usage for language software so does changing make sense?
- Is it possible to get a trial of Rosetta Stone?
- Note: OverDrive has some resources for language learning.
- In terms of Collection Development, should complement not replicate (some people looking to take deep dives into a language may require an audio disk)

5. RBdigital E-Magazine Collection order

Update from Merribeth Advocate

- Add second copy of Economist now (pro-rated) with January renewal of 2 copies.
- Auto-renewal feature has been turned on.
- Funding this will continue as it has previously.

6. OverDrive:

A. <u>Review Advantage Account activities</u>

- Content purchasing made a leap forward from invoicing to Advantage Accounts.
- Recommendation: Purchasing is the only way to meet the demand; so going forward send an email to member libraries without Advantage Accounts with a bill if content not purchased by certain date.

B. Changes to User Policy regarding number of checkouts & holds

- Recommend DA to increase the number of simultaneous OverDrive holds that a patron can have at one time from 10 to 15.
- Discussion: Awareness that increasing holds increases ratio, no distinction between e-book or audio-book with regard to holds, holds info helps to guide purchasing,

C. Overdrive Video Discussion

 Need to get info out to members that videos are available for purchase in OverDrive Marketplace.

- Viewable in web browser.
- Titles are searchable in the OPAC.
- Patrons can check OverDrive streaming video titles out for 3 or 5 or 7 days, but it is mandated that they only have it for "48 hours after first playback". Streaming Video purchasing is similar to copies of DVDs in that one patron can check out the title at a time.

7. Training – with Deb Weltch.

A. 2018 training

- Score High Marks at Your Library well received, covered subscription and not subscription resources.
- Discussion: Issue of basic computer literacy can hinder / discourage use of digital resources, so it is good to have print materials available.

B. 2019 training

- Spring: Collection Development Assessments
- Fall: Media Literacy/Helping Patrons Evaluate Information Sources
- Discussion: Important and timely topic.
